With Respect to the Use of Low Voltage and Other Electric Appliances While Providing Chiropractic Services, Please Take Note of the Following Recommendations:

- 1. Use of electric appliance in chiropractic treatments should be limited to trained individuals.
- 2. A practitioner shall be on the premises while said electrical appliances are being administered.
- 3. An electrical appliance should never be placed on the precordial area of any patient for obvious reasons.
- 4. Maintenance and testing on all electrical devices should be carried out regularly by trained technicians adhering to the manufacturer's schedule and recommendations to ensure that the machine is functioning properly.
- 5. A Maintenance table of scheduled and conducted tests should be maintained in the clinic and made available for review by a Board representative.
